[MUSLIM MINDANAO AUTONOMY ACT NO. 119]

Begun and held in Cotabato City, on Monday the twenty-third day of April, two thousand one.

AN ACT CREATING BARANGAY MAKUPA IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF INDANAN, PROVINCE OF SULU, APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFOR, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Be it enacted by the Regional Legislative Assembly in session assembled:

SECTION 1. The Sitio of Makupa is hereby created into a separate, distinct and regular barangay in the Municipality of Indanan, Province of Sulu to be known as Barangay Makupa;

SEC. 2. Barangay Makupa is contains a land area of Three Square Kilometers (3.0 sq. Km.), more or less, bounded as follows:

“From the point of origin, Point 1, the line moves due North for 2,000 meters towards point 2 by Barangay Pasil, thence going East for 1,500 meters by Barangay Manggis to point 3, thence continues moving South for 2,000 meters by Barangay Kabbon Gas to point 4, thence going West for 1,500 meters by Barangay Kandang Tukay closing the traverse and going back to the point of origin, Point 1.”

SEC. 3. Immediately after the ratification of this Act, the Punong Barangay and seven (7) members of the sangguniang barangay shall be appointed by the mayor of Indanan Municipality; while the chairman and seven (7) members of the sangguniang kabataan shall be appointed by the

concerned punong barangay: Provided, That they shall hold office until their successors shall have been duly elected and qualified in their next sangguniang regular elections; Provided, Further, That they shall exercise their duties and powers specified under Republic Act 6734, Muslim Mindanao Autonomy Act 25, and other existing rules and regulations.

SEC. 4. The corporate existence of Barangay Makupa shall commence upon the appointment or election and qualification of the punong barangay and a majority of the sangguniang barangay members.

SEC. 5. The Sangguniang Bayan shall provide for the necessary allowances and other benefits of the appointed barangay officials out of the municipal funds until the regular allocation from the national government shall have been released to the new barangay.

SEC. 6. The Commission on Elections shall conduct and supervise the plebiscite, which shall be held within ninety (90) days after the approval of this Act.

SEC. 7. The expenses required for the plebiscite shall be appropriated out of any available funds in the treasury of the Municipality of Indanan, Province of Sulu, as may be determined by its sangguniang bayan.

SEC. 8. The creation of Barangay Makupa shall take effect when approved by a majority of the votes cast in the plebiscite called for the purpose in the local government units directly affected.

SEC. 9. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
