**[MUSLIM MINDANAO AUTONOMY ACT NO. 127]**

**Begun and held in Cotabato City, on Monday the twenty-third day of April, two thousand and one.**

**“AN ACT AMENDING SECTIONS ONE AND TWO OF MUSLIM MINDANAO AUTONOMY ACT NUMBER ONE HUNDRED FOURTEEN AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.”**

**Be it enacted by the Regional Legislative Assembly in session assembled:**

**SECTION 1. Section one of Muslim Mindanao Autonomy Act Number One Hundred Fourteen is hereby amended, in part, to read as follows:**

**“The Sitio of Langtad is hereby created into a separate, distinct and regular barangay to be known as Barangay Lugmah out of the existing mother Barangay Bunot, Kabbon Maas, Licup, Manilop and Kan Islam in the Municipality of Indanan, Province of Sulu.”**

**SEC. 2 . Section two thereof is hereby likewise amended, to read as follows:**

**The territorial jurisdiction of Barangay Lugmah is defined by the following description:**


**“Beginning at a point marked 1-2 thence bearing N23°58'E, 4,456m, along line 2-3 bearing S72°16'E, 3,251 m, along line 3-4 bearing S68°31'W, 1,513 m, along line 4-1 bearing S54°09'W, 4,316 m, closing the traverse and going back to the point of origin.**

**SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.**
