THIRD LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY
(Sixth Regular Session)

[MUSLIM MINDANAO AUTONOMY ACT NO. 132]

Begun and held in Cotabato City, on Monday the twenty-third day of April, two thousand and one.

“AN ACT AMENDING SECTIONS ONE AND TWO OF
MUSLIM MINDANAO AUTONOMY ACT
NUMBER ONE HUNDRED NINETEEN
AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.”

Be it enacted by the Regional Legislative Assembly in session assembled:

SECTION 1. Section one of Muslim Mindanao Autonomy Act Number One Hundred Nineteen is hereby amended, in part, to read as follows:

“The Sitios of Tambak, Pansul 3 and Bato Pasagih is hereby created into a separate, distinct and regular barangay to be known as Barangay Makupa out of the existing mother barangays Tagbak, Buanza, Tumantangis and Kajatian in the Municipality of Indanan, Province of Sulu. “


SEC. 2 . Section two thereof is hereby likewise amended, to read as follows:

The territorial jurisdiction of Barangay Makupa is defined by the following description:


“Beginning at a point marked 1-2 thence bearing N72°39'W, 3,010 m, along line 2-3 bearing N39°42'E, 3,520 m, along line 3-4 bearing S38°12'W, 2,800 m, along line 4-1 bearing S38°13'W, 1,797 m, closing the traverse and going back to the point of origin.

SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
