THIRD LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY
(Sixth Regular Session)

[MUSLIM MINDANAO AUTONOMY ACT NO. 133]

Begun and held in Cotabato City, on Monday the twenty-third day of April, two thousand and one.

“AN ACT AMENDING SECTIONS ONE AND TWO OF MUSLIM MINDANAO AUTONOMY ACT NUMBER ONE HUNDRED TWENTY AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.”

Be it enacted by the Regional Legislative Assembly in session assembled:

SECTION 1. Section one of Muslim Mindanao Autonomy Act Number One Hundred Twenty is hereby amended, in part, to read as follows:

“The Sitios of Kan Anjao, Tubig Bios, Kan Jana, Kan Salasatul, Kan Jaman, Lanao Dakulah and Pang-pang is hereby created into a separate, distinct and regular barangay to be known as Barangay Kan Anjao out of the existing mother barangays Tubig Dakulah and Bud-Taran in the Municipality of Indanan, Province of Sulu”.


SEC. 2 . Section two thereof is hereby likewise amended, to read as follows:

The territorial jurisdiction of Barangay Kan Anjao is defined by the following description:


“Beginning at a point marked 1-2 thence bearing N53°30'W, 1,500 m, along line 2-3 bearing N36°30'E, 1,500 m, along line 3-4 bearing S53°30'E, 1,500 m, along line 4-1 bearing S36°30'W, 1,500 m, closing the traverse and going back to the point of origin.”

SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
