[MUSLIM MINDANAO AUTONOMY ACT NO. 145]

Begun and held in Cotabato City, on Monday, the twenty eighth day of October, two thousand two.

AN ACT CREATING BARANGAY TUAYAN I IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF SHARIFF AGUAK, PROVINCE OF MAGUINDANAO, AUTHORIZING APPROPRIATION THEREFOR, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.


Be it enacted by the Regional Legislative Assembly in session assembled:


SECTION 1. The sitios of Lower Atos, Batunan, Paglas, Pamibingan and Datu Aliman are hereby created into a separate, distinct and regular barangay to be known as Barangay Tuayan I in the Municipality of Shariff Aguak, Province of Maguindanao from its mother Barangay Tuayan.

SEC. 2. As created, Barangay Tuayan I shall be bounded by natural and duly designated boundaries with a total area of 719.10 hectares more specifically described as follows:

“From the point of origin, Point 1, the line moves due Northeast bearing 87°24' for 1,550 meters towards Point 2, thence going Southeast bearing 16°02' with a distance of 2,529 meters to Point 3, thence continues moving Southwest bearing 2°18' for 1,231 meters towards Point 4, thence continuing Southwest bearing 88°08' for 2,009 meters to Point 5, thence moving Northwest bearing 1°32' with a distance of 3,660 meters along Barangay Macalag closing the traverse and going back to the point of origin, Point 1.”

SEC. 3. The corporate existence of this Barangay shall commence upon the appointment of the punong Barangay and majority of the members of its Sangguniang Barangay.

SEC. 4. The punong barangay and seven (7) members of the Sangguniang Barangay shall be appointed by the Mayor of the Municipality of Shariff Aguak immediately after the ratification of this Act.

While the Chairman and seven (7) members of the Sangguniang Kabataan shall be appointed by the punong Barangay concerned after consultation with the Municipal Mayor and Department of Interior and Local Government-ARMM.

All concerned shall hold office and perform their respective functions until their successors are elected and qualified in the next barangay and Sangguniang Kabataan regular elections.

SEC. 5. The Commission on Elections (COMELEC) shall conduct and supervise the plebiscite called for the purpose in the affected areas within ninety(90) days as may be requested by the Municipal Mayor after the approval of this Act.


SEC. 6. This Barangay shall be entitled to an equitable share from the annual Internal Revenue Allotment share of its Mother Barangay until its own annual share from Internal Revenue Allotment(IRA) is determined and released by the national government.

SEC. 7. The expenses necessary in the holding of plebiscite shall be appropriated by the Sangguniang Bayan concerned from any available funds in its Municipal Treasury.

SEC. 8. The creation of Barangay Tuayan I shall take effect when approved by a majority of the votes cast in the plebiscite called for the purpose in the areas affected.






