[MUSLIM MINDANAO AUTONOMY ACT 81]

AN ACT CREATING BARANGAY TALIBANG IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF INDANAN, PROVINCE OF SULU, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Be it enacted by the Regional Legislative Assembly in session assembled:

Section 1. Barangay Talibang is hereby created as a separate and distinct barangay out of the existing sitios of Barangays Kagay, Tagbak, Tumangtangis and Buansa in the Municipality of Indanan, Province of Sulu.

SEC. 2. The territorial jurisdiction of Barangay Talibang is defined by the following description:

"On the north by Barangay Tumangtangis; on the east by Barangay Kagay; on the west by Barangay Tagbak; and on the south by Barangay Buansa."

SEC. 3. Immediately after the ratification of this Act, the punong barangay and seven (7) members of the sangguniang barangay shall be appointed by the mayor of Indanan Municipality; while the chairman and seven (7) members of the sangguniang kabataan shall be appointed by the concerned punong barangay: Provided, That they shall hold office until their successors shall have been duly elected and qualified in their next sangguniang regular elections: Provided, Further, That they shall exercise their duties and powers specified under Republic Act 6734, Muslim Mindanao Autonomy Act 25, and other existing rules and regulations.

SEC. 4. The corporate existence of Barangay Talibang shall commence upon the appointment and qualification of the punong barangay and a majority of the sangguniang members.


SEC. 5. The sangguniang bayan shall provide for the necessary allowances and other benefits of the appointed barangay officials out of the municipal funds until the regular allocation from the national government shall have been released to the new barangay.

SEC. 6. The Commission on Election shall conduct and supervise the plebiscite which shall be held within ninety (90) days after the approval of this Act.


SEC. 7. The expenses required for the plebiscite shall be appropriated out of any available funds in the treasury of the municipality of Indanan as may be determined by its sangguniang bayan.

SEC. 8. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
