RLA BILL 42

THIRD LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY
(Fourth Regular Session)

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Begun and held in Cotabato City on Tuesday, the twenty-seventh day of April, nineteen hundred and ninety nine.

[MUSLIM MINDANAO AUTONOMY ACT 84]

AN ACT CREATING BARANGAY SUMBAGO IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF BAYANG, PROVINCE OF LANAO DEL SUR, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Be it enacted by the Regional Legislative Assembly in session assembled:

SECTION 1. Sitio Sumbago is hereby separated from its mother Barangay Parao in the Municipality of Bayang, Province of Lanao del Sur, and is created into a separate and distinct regular barangay in the same municipality and province.

SEC. 2. Barangay Sumbago is bounded by natural and duly designated boundaries, more specifically described as follows:

"Beginning at the boundary line of Bagoinged on the North and up to boundary line of Barangay Parao on the Eastern direction; thence, on the Western direction indicating the boundary line of Barangay Gandamato."

SEC. 3. Immediately after the ratification of this Act, the punong barangay and seven (7) members of the sangguniang barangay shall be appointed by the mayor of Bayang Municipality; while the chairman and seven (7) members of the sangguniang kabataan shall be appointed by the concerned punong barangay: Provided, That they shall hold office

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until their successors shall have been duly elected and qualified in their next sangguniang regular elections: Provided, Further, That they shall exercise their duties and powers specified under Republic Act 6734, Muslim Mindanao Autonomy Act 25, and other existing rules and regulations.

SEC. 4. The corporate existence of Barangay Sumbago shall commence upon the appointment and qualification of the punong barangay and a majority of the sangguniang barangay members.


SEC. 5. The sangguniang bayan shall provide for the necessary allowances and other benefits of the appointed barangay officials out of the municipal funds until the regular allocation from the national government shall have been released to the new barangay.

SEC. 6. The Commission on Elections shall conduct and supervise the plebiscite which shall be held within ninety (90) days after the approval of this Act.


SEC. 7. The expenses necessary in the plebiscite shall be provided by the municipal government of Bayang as may be determined by its Sangguniang Bayan.

SEC. 8. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
